### **Free Bicycle Health Check**

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of the ongoing partnership between Sustrans Active School Travel Programme and St. Joseph's Primary School, we are happy to be able to offer pupils the chance to take part in a free Bicycle Health Check known as ***Dr Bike!***

Iain Sneddon, the school's Active Travel Officer, will be at the school on **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> June** to give bikes a general health check.

A typical check involves pumping up tyres and checking brakes, handlebars, saddle and pedals. If there is time, small adjustments will be made, but this is not a substitute for a full service. A photo note will be sent to the school identifying anything on the bike that needs urgent attention.

To take part, all your child needs to do is bring their bike to school on **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> June**

#### **Safeguarding against Covid-19**

- During the Dr Bike session the Active Travel Officer will disinfect bikes before and after contact.
- Communication about defects that the Active Travel Officer cannot repair will be communicated to the school via a photograph to be passed on to the bike's owner.
- A 2m social distance will be maintained by the Active Travel Officer from any pupil and member of staff during the visit to the school.
